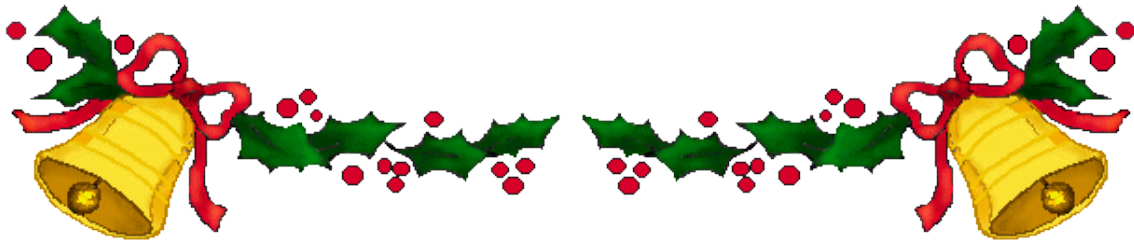


St Luke's Christmas Fair – Help required
